**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF A FORMAL APPLICATION AND
BUSINESS PLAN FOR THE IRON WORKS CATASAUQUA PROJECT UNDER THE
REDEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE CAPITAL PROGRAM.**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Catasauqua (hereinafter, "Borough") has proposed the redevelopment of the former Crane Iron Works/FL Smidth/Fuller Company property along Front Street in Catasauqua, PA based upon a mix of commercial, residential and other authorized land uses in a project known as "Iron Works Catasauqua" (hereinafter, "Project") and

WHEREAS, the Borough submitted a request to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for grant funding through the Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (hereinafter, "RACP") to support infrastructure construction, abatement of hazardous materials, and other related costs associated with the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has awarded to the Borough a One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollar (\$1,500,000.00) grant through the RACP to support the Project (hereinafter, "Grant").


