

Full Time Police Officer Examination

The Catasauqua Civil Service Commission will be conducting civil service examinations for full time entry-level patrol officer positions in the Borough of Catasauqua Police Department. The examination process includes a written examination, an oral examination, a physical fitness test, and a background investigation, and any appointment to a position in the Department shall be contingent upon passing physical and psychological examinations. The date, time, and place for the first portion of the examination, the written examination, will be determined by the Civil Service Commission on or about October 3, 2024.

Any person who desires to participate in the examination process must obtain an official application form from the office of the Borough Manager at the Catasauqua Borough Hall, 90 Bridge Street, Catasauqua, PA 18032, or at www.catasauqua.org. Completed and signed application forms, together with an application fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00), must be submitted to the office of the Borough Manager, Catasauqua Borough Hall, 90 Bridge Street, Catasauqua, PA 18032 during normal business hours or by mail, and must be received there no later than 3:30 p.m. on September 27, 2024. **The Borough is not participating in the next application and examination cycle for entry-level police positions conducted by the Lehigh County Chiefs of Police Consortium**, so any person desiring to apply for a position with the Borough of Catasauqua Police Department at this time or in the near future should apply through the Catasauqua Civil Service Commission as described in this advertisement.

All applicants must have reached their 21st birthday before the deadline for submitting completed applications. Applicants shall, within two (2) years of being employed by the Borough, reside within the Borough or within fifty (50) air miles of the nearest Borough boundary. An applicant must possess a diploma from an accredited high school or a graduate equivalency diploma, must be a United States citizen, must be physically and mentally able to perform the essential functions of the position with or without reasonable accommodation, and must be currently certified by the Pennsylvania Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission. In addition, an applicant must possess a valid Pennsylvania driver's license, speak, read, and write the English language, and be of good moral character.
